



## **PARENT OBSERVATION DURING COVID**

As always, the well-being of our club members remains a top priority. To continue providing a healthy training environment for our athletes and staff, ASA has enhanced facility protocols and sanitization processes to align with guidelines from both the CDC and the PA Department of Health. Until further notice, anyone visiting the gym office for customer service is asked to wear a mask while inside the building. The ASA staff will be wearing face coverings/masks. Gymnasts must wear their mask when entering and exiting the building and in all common areas including the lobby, lounge and bathrooms. Masks are welcome and encouraged in the training area, but are not required for gymnasts during active training. Updates regarding facility protocols will be sent to all members as they become available.

Parents are welcome in the facility at any time, whether it be for customer service or to bring their athlete for training. Please be mindful of social distancing while in the lobby area and limit one parent/guardian per athlete whenever possible. It's important to note that our spectator area is currently closed for "seated viewing". Parents may use the windows and doorways to watch a portion of the class and/or check on their children at any time, but cannot sit on the observation benches to watch a full session. You're encouraged to drop off/pick up, talk a walk, run errands, or sit in the car whenever possible to help us maintain low traffic in the lobby area. If you have questions about club policies, please feel free to contact the gym office and we will assist you. We look forward to lifted restrictions in the future, but until then feel it's incredibly important to err on the side of caution and do everything we can to reduce risks for our athletes, staff members, and their families.
